

Workforce Stabilization Incentive Program Application


The Department of Human Services (DHS) has opened an application to all eligible Medicaid Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) providers to participate in the Workforce Stabilization Provider Incentive Program as detailed in the Arkansas American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Section 9817 HCBS Spending Plan.

The deadline to submit applications is **Friday, March 11, 2022, at 11:59 p.m. CT.** Due to time restrictions related to the ARPA Section 9817 legislation, DHS cannot provide extensions.

Providers that do not apply will **NOT** receive funds from the Workforce Stabilization Provider Incentive Program.
